A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to require the annual reporting of data on enrollment in Medicare Advantage plans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Advantage
5 Coverage Transparency Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR ENROLLMENT DATA REPORT-**
2 **ING FOR MEDICARE ADVANTAGE.**

3 Section 1859 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
4 1395w-28) is amended by adding at the end the following
5 new subsection:

6 “(h) REQUIREMENT FOR ENROLLMENT DATA RE-
7 PORTING.—

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than May 1 of
9 each year (beginning with 2016), the Secretary shall
10 submit to the Committees on Ways and Means and
11 Energy and Commerce of the House of Representa-
12 tives and the Committee on Finance of the Senate
13 a report on enrollment data of the plan year ending
14 before January 1 of such year. Such enrollment data
15 shall be presented—

16 “(A) by zip code, congressional district,
17 and State; and

18 “(B) in a manner that provides for such
19 data for each MA-PD plan and for each MA
20 plan that is not an MA-PD plan.

21 “(2) DELAY OF DEADLINE.—If the Secretary is
22 unable to submit a report under paragraph (1) by
23 May 1 of year for data of the plan year ending be-
24 fore January 1 of such year, the Secretary shall, not
25 later than April 30 of such year notify the commit-
26 tees described in such paragraph of—

1 “(A) such inability, including an expla-
2 nation for such inability; and

3 “(B) the date by which the Secretary will
4 provide such report, which shall be not later
5 than June 1 of such year.”.
