Changes to H.R. 3046
As included in Chairman Rangel's Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute

Section 2: Added clarification that SSNs may be sold by government agencies if authorized by the Privacy Act of 1974.

Added temporary exception permitting government agencies to sell or display to the general public the last four digits of SSNs for two years after the effective date of the final regulations.

Section 8: Added temporary exception permitting the private sector to sell, purchase or display to the general public the last four digits of SSNs for two years after the effective date of the final regulations.

Section 9: Clarified reference in new misdemeanor violation for unlawful possession of another's or a fraudulent SSN card to require an intent to use the SSN in furtherance of a violation of law.

Section 10: Same change as in Section 9.

Section 11: Deleted redundant reference to conspiracy to commit a violation by SSA employees.

Section 12: Clarified reference for violations committed in connection with crimes of violence to refer to violence against persons.

Technical changes: Made several changes to correct cross references in the bill and other technical changes.
