A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TRADE ADJUSTMENT ASSIST-**
4 **ANCE PROGRAM FOR 3 MONTHS.**

5 (a) ASSISTANCE FOR WORKERS.—Section 245(a) of
6 the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2317(a)) is amended
7 by striking “September 30, 2007” and inserting “Decem-
8 ber 31, 2007”.

1 (b) ASSISTANCE FOR FIRMS.—Section 256(b) of the
2 Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2346(b)) is amended by
3 inserting after “2007,” the following: “, and \$4,000,000
4 for the 3-month period beginning on October 1, 2007”.

5 (c) ASSISTANCE FOR FARMERS.—Section 298(a) of
6 the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2401g(a)) is amended
7 by inserting before the period the following: “, and there
8 are authorized to be appropriated to the Department of
9 Agriculture to carry out this chapter \$22,500,000 for the
10 3-month period beginning on October 1, 2007”.

11 (d) EXTENSION OF TERMINATION DATES.—Section
12 285 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2271 note) is
13 amended by striking “September 30” each place it ap-
14 pears and inserting “December 31”.
