

**Description of Changes of the Chairman's Amendment in the  
Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 5264  
(Green Sheet)**

The Chairman's mark makes the following changes to H.R. 5264: (1) it changes the short title of the bill from "Trade Preference Extension Act of 2008" to "Andean Trade Preference Extension Act of 2008"; (2) it strikes the findings regarding the preference programs in section 2; (3) it strikes section 3, which extended the Generalized System of Preferences (GSP) until September 30, 2010, modified the current GSP provisions dealing with Competitive Need Limitations (CNLs), and expressed a sense of Congress regarding the on-going World Trade Organization (WTO) Doha negotiations; (4) it strikes section 4, which extended the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act until September 30, 2010; (5) it changes the date of the extension of the Andean Trade Preference Act (ATPA) from September 30, 2010 to December 31, 2008 and makes other conforming changes to ATPA, and strikes a sense of Congress regarding the eligibility criteria in the program; and (6) it strikes the amendments to the African Growth And Opportunity Act (AGOA) in section 6.
