

**Description of Changes in the  
Chairman's Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 5749  
(Green Sheet)**

The Chairman's amendment in the nature of a substitute makes the following changes to HR 5749:

In Section 2 (b), it adds a technical clarification ensuring that an individual's potential eligibility for the current-law extended benefits (EB) program does not affect eligibility for the bill's Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC) if a State opts to provide EUC before EB.

In Section 3 (c), it allows individuals exhausting the first 13 weeks of EUC either before or at the same time a State meets the requisite high unemployment trigger to receive an additional 13 weeks of benefits if the individual remains unemployed and in search of work.
