**SMALL BUSINESS ENDORSES THE JOBS ACT (H.R. 4520)**

Dear Representative:

On behalf of the 600,000 members of the National Federation of Independent Business (NFIB), I urge you vote for H.R. 4520, The American Jobs Creation Act of 2004.

If enacted, H.R. 4520 will:

- ✓ Extend Section 179 expensing limits until 2007. Currently, the provision expires at the end of 2005.
- ✓ Create a new 32 percent top rate for corporations with less than \$20 million of taxable income.
- ✓ Decrease the leasehold and restaurant depreciation lives from 39 years to 15 years.
- ✓ Expand the size of companies exempt from the corporate alternative minimum tax from \$7.5 million in gross receipts to \$20 million in gross receipts.

H.R. 4520 will provide a total of **\$84 billion dollars** in tax relief to America's small businesses.

**The vote on H.R. 4520 will be an NFIB Key Small-Business Vote for the 108<sup>th</sup> Congress.**
