

Tariff suspension bills introduced by Congressman Huelskamp**

Dear Representatives Camp, Levin, Brady and McDermott:

I write on behalf of Global Tungsten & Powders (GTP) a United States producer of specialty chemicals and refractory powders. On June 22nd of this year I wrote to state GTP's objections to bills designated as: HR 5113, HR 5114, HR 5116, HR 5118, HR 5122, HR 5123, HR 5125, HR 5125, HR 5126, HR 5127 and HR 5128. The bills are tariff suspensions sponsored by Congressman Huelskamp of Kansas and requested by Philips Electronics, a US manufacturer of fluorescent lights. GTP wishes to convey to the Committee on Ways and Means that our previously stated objections to this legislation are withdrawn.
