For instance, NCTO wrote, "I don't see why this can't be made in the US or the region," while Milliken wrote, "We do not at this time incorporate electrodes." Objections to the legislation are hypothetical or related to other inputs and ignore the integrated heart rate electrode, which is the central feature of the good.
