RE: NCTO Opposition to H.R. 4973 – Withdrawal Letter


Dear Chairmen Camp and Baucus:

In our letter dated June 20, 2012, the National Council of Textile Organizations (NCTO) stated its opposition to H.R. 4973, a proposed suspension of duty relating to certain sleeping bag carrying cases.

The bill sponsor, Rep. Robert Aderholt (R-AL), has proposed a language change to H.R. 4973 and given the proposed change, NCTO agrees to rescind its letter of opposition. NCTO has determined that our member companies would not be adversely affected once the bill is amended as requested by the sponsoring office.
