To whom it may concern:

The National Textile Association supports the extension of the suspension of duty on nylon woolpacks. Our interest is indirect. Among our members are companies who purchase American-grown wool fiber which they process into textile products in the U.S. The suspension of the duty on the woolpacks, which are used to package the wool, benefits the U.S. industry in two ways. First, U.S. wool textile processors benefit from the money savings that wool growers can pass on due to the savings on import duties on nylon woolpacks. Second, the lower price of the nylon woolpacks due to duty savings is an incentive for wool growers to use the superior nylon sacks rather than woolpacks of cheaper materials that could contaminate the wool, creating difficulties for U.S. wool textile producers.
