
Dear Assistant Secretary Michaels,

As you know, the House Committee on Ways and Means is conducting an investigation related to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration's May 14, 2013 audit report, "Inappropriate Criteria Were Used to Identify Tax-Exempt Applications for Review." The day after the report was released, President Obama promised to "work with Congress as it performs its oversight role. And [to] work hand in hand with Congress to get this thing fixed." Given the revelation on June 13, 2014 that the Internal Revenue Service had lost key evidence relating to the targeting of conservative organizations on the basis of name and policy position, we are writing to request critical assistance that only the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) can provide.
