Dear Mr. Speaker:

I write on behalf of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") to express our support for H.R. 4718 to make permanent important tax provisions that expired at the end of 2013. In particular, we support the provisions in H.R. 4718 that permanently extends bonus depreciation, and in particular voice our strong support for including the accelerated Alternative Minimum Tax (AMT) recovery in lieu of bonus depreciation.

As an exclusively domestic wireless telecommunications carrier, T-Mobile is committed to domestic investment that creates jobs in the United States and grows our economy. As a US taxpayer with substantial AMT credits, passage of H.R. 4718 will immediately free up much needed capital locked in the Treasury and help T-Mobile purchase additional spectrum from the FCC and make additional capital investments in our advanced wireless network in 2015 and 2016. This is ready capital sitting on the sidelines that, if authorized by Congress, will help boost the U.S. economy and lead to greater job creation in several important growth sectors of the US economy, including telecommunications.

We thank you and the Ways and Means Committee for taking action on this important issue.
