

Amendment Offered by Ms. Sewell of Alabama

This amendment would add two state performance indicators (Sec. 7) measuring the percentage of individuals who obtain a credential, and the percentage of work-eligible individuals who received family stabilization services through the program or through referral to another State or Federal program.

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5861

OFFERED BY MS. SEWELL OF ALABAMA

Page 9, after line 18, insert the following:

1 “(v) The percentage of individuals
2 who obtain a credential, as described in
3 clause (i) of section 116(b)(2)(A) of the
4 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity
5 Act, and meet the condition described in
6 clause (iii) of such section.
7 “(vi) The percentage of individuals
8 who were work-eligible individuals who re-
9 ceived family stabilization services through
10 the program or through referral to another
11 State or Federal program, without which
12 the individuals would not have been able to
13 be employed. In the preceding sentence,
14 the term ‘family stabilization services’
15 means housing, transportation assistance,
16 food assistance, or health care.”.

Page 10, line 3, strike “40” and insert “20”.

Page 10, line 6, strike “25” and insert “20”.

Page 10, line 9, strike “25” and insert “20”.

Page 10, after line 14, insert the following:

1 “(V) 20 percent, in the case of
2 the indicator described in subpara-
3 graph (B)(v).

4 “(VI) 10 percent, in the case of
5 the indicator described in subpara-
6 graph (B)(vi).”.
