## Amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 3398 Offered by Rep. Walorski of Indiana

This amendment dedicates any funding above the historic level of \$85 million per year to a "pay for outcomes" financing structure.

## AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3398 OFFERED BY MRS. WALORSKI OF INDIANA

Page 30, line 7, insert before the semicolon the following: ", of which any amount in excess of \$85,000,000 may only be used for pay for outcomes initiatives (as defined in paragraph (3))".

Page 31, after line 6, insert the following:

1 (3) PAY FOR OUTCOMES INITIATIVE.—The term "pay for outcomes initiative" means a performance-2 3 based grant, contract, cooperative agreement, or 4 other agreement awarded by an eligible entity in 5 which a commitment is made to pay for improved 6 outcomes that result in social benefit and direct cost 7 savings or cost avoidance to the public sector. Such 8 an initiative shall include— 9

9 (A) a feasibility study on the initiative de-10 scribing how the proposed intervention is based 11 on strong or moderate evidence of effectiveness; 12 (B) a rigorous, third-party evaluation that 13 uses experimental designs employing random 14 assignment when feasible, or quasi-experimental  $\mathbf{2}$ 

designs or other research methodologies that 1 2 allow for the strongest possible causal infer-3 ences when random assignment is not feasible to determine whether the initiative has met its 4 5 proposed outcomes 6 (C) an annual, publicly available report on 7 the progress of the initiative; and 8 (D) a requirement that all or part of the 9 payments made to the recipient of a grant, con-10 tract, cooperative agreement, or other agreement are conditional on achieving the agreed-11 12 upon outcomes, except that the entity may make payments to the third party conducting 13 the evaluation described in subparagraph (B). 14

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
