



ADVISORY: GOP Meeting: "Biden's Crippling Tax Hikes Will Decimate Americans' Shrinking Paychecks"

Reps. Kevin Brady (R-TX), Ways and Means Republican Leader, and Mike Kelly (R-PA), top Republican for the Select Revenue Measures Subcommittee, announced today they will host a meeting titled **"Biden's Crippling Tax Hikes Will Decimate Americans' Shrinking Paychecks"** on **Wednesday, May 4, at 12 PM EDT**.

The meeting will feature a discussion on issues confronting working families, including <u>40-year high inflation</u>, the labor shortage, and bungled supply chains.

Republicans have answers to help Americans have a more stable and prosperous future by making tax reform permanent, creating jobs, and promoting "Made in America" manufacturing.

THEMES FOR MEETING:

- Bidenflation is surging, and now Democrats want crippling tax hikes.
- President Biden's latest budget proposes \$2.5 trillion in new taxes that hike the <u>U.S. tax rates to the worst in the developed</u> world and hit working families and Main Street job creators hardest.

<u>Experts agree</u> Washington spending fueled inflation and has the economy <u>shrinking towards a recession</u>.

BACKGROUND:

- **40-year high inflation tax slashes workers' wages:** Higher taxes will result in even higher prices for consumers, when American families already paid a <u>\$5,000 inflation tax in 2021</u>.
- Tax hikes send jobs and investment fleeing overseas: Small businesses are still desperate to fill openings after President Biden discouraged work. A new <u>study by the Tax Foundation</u> found that President Biden's tax hikes would destroy at least 138,000 U.S. jobs.
- Made-in-America tax worsens supply chain crises: Democrats harmful <u>Made-in-America tax</u> exacerbates supply-chain disruptions, and sends U.S. jobs and investment overseas at a time when a <u>majority of small businesses fear</u> Bidenflation will close down their business.
