## VOTES OF THE COMMITTEE

In compliance with the Rules of the House of Representatives, the following statement is made concerning the vote of the Committee on Ways and Means during the markup consideration of H.R. 8915, the "Education and Workforce Freedom Act," on July 9, 2024.

The vote on the amendment offered by Mr. Doggett to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8915, which would provide that any distribution from a 529 with respect to homeschool expenses is subject to Federal income tax if the distribute, or anyone who can claim the distribute as a dependent on their Federal income tax return, has adjusted gross income in excess of \$1,000,000 for the taxable year in which the distribution occurred was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas to 22 nays (with a quorum being present).
