In compliance with the Rules of the House of Representatives, the following statement is made concerning the vote of the Committee on Ways and Means during the markup consideration of H.R. 8245, the "Rural Hospital Stabilization Act," on May 8, 2024.

The vote on the amendment offered by Ms. Sanchez to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8245, which would expand eligibility for the pilot program to disproportionate share hospitals, federally qualified health centers, and rural health centers. It would also require the Secretary of Health and Human Services to consider hospitals that serve low-income patients, or are located in a health professional shortage area was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 18 yeas to 23 nays (with a quorum being present).
