

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Georgia Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for Georgia Residents on December 31, 2025:

- Georgia is home to 6,289,110 taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Georgia would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$74,632, the median income in Georgia, would see a \$1,515 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on Georgia Residents by the Numbers		
1,295,770	Georgia families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
88%	of Georgia taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
655,740	Small Businesses in Georgia would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
182,085	Georgia taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
37,301	Family-Owned Farms in Georgia would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
