

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Mississippi Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for Mississippi Residents on December 31, 2025:

- Mississippi is home to **1,604,260** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Mississippi would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$54,203, the median income in Mississippi, would see a **\$1,280** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 7 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on Mississippi Residents by the Numbers		
358,930	Mississippi families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
94%	of Mississippi taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
129,030	Small Businesses in Mississippi would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
21,127	Mississippi taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
29,413	Family-Owned Farms in Mississippi would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
