

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Nevada Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Nevada Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Nevada is home to 1,985,280 taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Nevada would see a **23% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$76,364, the median income in Nevada, would see a **\$1,567** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about **7 weeks of groceries** to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on Nevada Residents by the Numbers		
374,010	Nevada families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
92%	of Nevada taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
182,710	Small Businesses in Nevada would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
27,855	Nevada taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
2,841	Family-Owned Farms in Nevada would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
