

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Pennsylvania Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for Pennsylvania Residents on December 31, 2025:

- Pennsylvania is home to 8,457,390 taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Pennsylvania would see a 24% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



- A **family of 4** making \$73,824, the median income in Pennsylvania, would see a **\$1,491** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about **7 weeks of groceries** to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on Pennsylvania Residents by the Numbers		
1,470,780	Pennsylvania families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
93%	of Pennsylvania taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
881,410	Small Businesses in Pennsylvania would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
261,927	Pennsylvania taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
46,600	Family-Owned Farms in Pennsylvania would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
