

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Rhode Island Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Rhode Island Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Rhode Island is home to **709,610** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Rhode Island would see a **21% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$84,972, the median income in Rhode Island, would see a \$**1,826** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 9 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on Rhode Island Residents by the Numbers		
124,760	Rhode Island families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
91%	of Rhode Island taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
78,390	Small Businesses in Rhode Island would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
24,834	Rhode Island taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
980	Family-Owned Farms in Rhode Island would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
