

## Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for South Dakota Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for South Dakota Residents on December 31, 2025:

- South Dakota is home to 606,720 taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in South Dakota would see a **25% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$71,810, the median income in South Dakota, would see a \$1,431 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



• This is worth about **7 weeks of groceries** to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on South Dakota Residents by the Numbers		
100,370	South Dakota families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
95%	of South Dakota taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
78,890	Small Businesses in South Dakota would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
6,685	South Dakota taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
26,318	Family-Owned Farms in South Dakota would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
