

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Wisconsin Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Wisconsin Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Wisconsin is home to **3,955,670** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Wisconsin would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$74,631, the median income in Wisconsin, would see a **\$1,515** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on Wisconsin Residents by the Numbers		
650,800	Wisconsin families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
93%	of Wisconsin taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
404,360	Small Businesses in Wisconsin would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
101,026	Wisconsin taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
55,595	Family-Owned Farms in Wisconsin would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
