RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President of the United States to furnish certain information to the House of Representatives relating to the operations of the Social Security Administration after January 20, 2025, including information on the Department of Government Efficiency's access to the Social Security Administration and to information in the possession of such Administration.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the President of the United States is
- 2 requested to furnish the House of Representatives, not

1 later than 14 days after the date of adoption of this reso-
2 lution, copies of any document, record, audio recording,
3 memorandum, call log, correspondence (electronic or oth-
4 erwise), audit trails and audit logs, written agreements,
5 or other communication in his possession, or any portion
6 of any document, record, audio recording, memorandum,
7 call log, correspondence (electronic or otherwise), or other
8 communication, that refers or relates to the following:

9 (1) Access to, or usage of, the Social Security
10 Administration’s information technology systems (in-
11 cluding systems used by the Administration to issue
12 and record social security account numbers, record
13 wages and earnings from self-employment, determine
14 eligibility for benefits, pay benefits, or to allow the
15 public to access information or services from the Ad-
16 ministration) by the Department of Government Ef-
17 ficiency (hereafter referred to as “DOGE”), Elon
18 Musk, any member of his team, or any individual co-
19 ordinating with the DOGE.

20 (2) Visits to Social Security Administration of-
21 fices by the DOGE, Elon Musk, or any member of
22 his team.

23 (3) Alignment and compliance by the Social Se-
24 curity Administration with Executive Orders 14148,
25 14151, 14160, 14168, 14170, and 14171 of Janu-

1 ary 20, 2025, Executive Order 14173 of January
2 21, 2025, Executive Order 14192 of January 31,
3 2025, and Executive Orders 14217 and 14219 of
4 February 19, 2025.

5 (4) The number of calls per day to the national
6 toll-free telephone number maintained by the Social
7 Security Administration for inquiries by the public,
8 for days after January 20, 2025, through the date
9 of enactment of this resolution.

10 (5) The number of calls per day and visitors
11 per day to Social Security Administration field of-
12 fices and card centers, for days after January 20,
13 2025, through the date of enactment of this resolu-
14 tion.

15 (6) The closure or consolidation of offices of the
16 Social Security Administration, including field of-
17 fices, card centers, and hearing offices, occurring in
18 2025.

19 (7) Reduction in staff at the Social Security
20 Administration, including at field offices, hearing of-
21 fices, teleservice centers, processing centers, work
22 support units, and other offices, occurring in 2025.
