

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Alaska Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Alaska Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Alaska is home to **460,010** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Alaska would see a 21% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$86,631, the median income in Alaska, would



see a **\$1,875** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.

 This is worth about 9 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on Alaska Residents by the Numbers		
85,290	Alaska families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
94%	of Alaska taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
58,610	Small Businesses in Alaska would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
5,931	Alaska taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
1,091	Family-Owned Farms in Alaska would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
