

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for NC-12 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for NC-12 Residents on December 31, 2025:

- NC-12 is home to **545,900** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in NC-12 would see a
 23% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$78,809, the median income in NC-12, would see a **\$1,640** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 9 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on NC-12 Residents by the Numbers		
100,760	NC-12 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
88%	of NC-12 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
76,150	Small Businesses in NC-12 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
18,717	NC-12 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
250	Family-Owned Farms in NC-12 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
