

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for TX-36 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>TX-36 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- TX-36 is home to **477,050** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in TX-36 would see a 23% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$77,440, the median income in TX-36, would see a **\$1,600** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.

 This is worth about 9 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on TX-36 Residents by the Numbers		
99,250	TX-36 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
92%	of TX-36 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
39,440	Small Businesses in TX-36 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
8,479	TX-36 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
4,990	Family-Owned Farms in TX-36 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
