

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for FL-14 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>FL-14 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- FL-14 is home to **529,330** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in FL-14 would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$72,238, the median income in FL-14, would see a **\$1,444** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on FL-14 Residents by the Numbers		
102,900	FL-14 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
93%	of FL-14 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
68,660	Small Businesses in FL-14 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
12,160	FL-14 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
187	Family-Owned Farms in FL-14 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
