

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for GA-10 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for GA-10 Residents on December 31, 2025:

- GA-10 is home to **387,380** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in GA-10 would see a
 24% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$72,143, the median income in GA-10, would see a **\$1,441** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on GA-10 Residents by the Numbers		
81,500	GA-10 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
90%	of GA-10 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
51,560	Small Businesses in GA-10 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
9,716	GA-10 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
5,045	Family-Owned Farms in GA-10 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
