

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for NC-11 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>NC-11 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- NC-11 is home to **505,160** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in NC-11 would see a 24% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$62,114, the median income in NC-11, would see a **\$1,140 tax** increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 6 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on NC-11 Residents by the Numbers		
73,530	NC-11 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
91%	of NC-11 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
70,210	Small Businesses in NC-11 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
9,016	NC-11 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
4,886	Family-Owned Farms in NC-11 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
