


Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for ND-01 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>ND-01 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- ND-01 is home to **501,880** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in ND-01 would see a **23% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$76,525, the median income in ND-01, would see a \$1,572 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on ND-01 Residents by the Numbers		
87,050	ND-01 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
94%	of ND-01 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
71,790	Small Businesses in ND-01 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
6,915	ND-01 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
23,815	Family-Owned Farms in ND-01 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
