


Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for CT-04 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>CT-04 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- CT-04 is home to **488,330** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in CT-04 would see a **18% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$117,299, the median income in CT-04, would see a **\$3,195** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 15 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on CT-04 Residents by the Numbers		
78,820	CT-04 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
79%	of CT-04 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
91,420	Small Businesses in CT-04 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
67,893	CT-04 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
230	Family-Owned Farms in CT-04 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
