

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for OR-04 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>OR-04 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- OR-04 is home to **505,130** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in OR-04 would see a **26% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$67,778, the median income in OR-04, would see a **\$1,310** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 6 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on OR-04 Residents by the Numbers		
74,140	OR-04 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
89%	of OR-04 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
56,670	Small Businesses in OR-04 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
11,773	OR-04 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
5,478	Family-Owned Farms in OR-04 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
