

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for MI-04 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>MI-04 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- MI-04 is home to **452,310** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in MI-04 would see a **25% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$69,754, the median income in MI-04, would see a **\$1,369** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 7 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on MI-04 Residents by the Numbers		
70,420	MI-04 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
95%	of MI-04 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
41,850	Small Businesses in MI-04 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
9,448	MI-04 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
3,084	Family-Owned Farms in MI-04 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
