

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Iowa Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Iowa Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Iowa is home to **2,055,130** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Iowa would see a **25% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$71,433, the median income in Iowa, would see a \$1,419 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 8 weeks
 of groceries to a typical
 family of 4 in the region.



Impact on Iowa Residents by the Numbers		
364,820	Iowa families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
94%	of Iowa taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
269,150	Small Businesses in Iowa would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
48,431	Iowa taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
80,827	Family-Owned Farms in Iowa would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
