

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Idaho Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for Idaho Residents on December 31, 2025:

- Idaho is home to **1,238,880** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Idaho would see a 24% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$74,942, the median income in Idaho, would see a **\$1,525** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 7 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on Idaho Residents by the Numbers		
220,720	Idaho families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
92%	of Idaho taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
151,710	Small Businesses in Idaho would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
23,560	Idaho taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
21,504	Family-Owned Farms in Idaho would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
