


Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for CT-01 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for CT-01 Residents on December 31, 2025:

- CT-01 is home to **471,770** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in CT-01 would see a 22% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$83,329, the median income in CT-01, would see a \$1,776 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on CT-01 Residents by the Numbers		
85,370	CT-01 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
90%	of CT-01 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
55,180	Small Businesses in CT-01 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
25,035	CT-01 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
565	Family-Owned Farms in CT-01 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
