

## Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for New Jersey Constituents

## Tax Hikes Looming for <u>New Jersey Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- New Jersey is home to **6,084,660** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in New Jersey would see a 20% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$99,781, the median income in New Jersey, would see a **\$2,270** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
  - This is worth about **11 weeks of groceries** to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on New Jersey Residents by the Numbers		
1,121,080	New Jersey families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
87%	of New Jersey taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
793,520	Small Businesses in New Jersey would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
470,276	New Jersey taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
9,398	Family-Owned Farms in New Jersey would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
