


Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for New Mexico Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>New Mexico Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- New Mexico is home to **1,276,530** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in New Mexico would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$62,268, the median income in New Mexico, would see a \$1,145 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 5 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on New Mexico Residents by the Numbers		
226,820	New Mexico families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
94%	of New Mexico taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
118,570	Small Businesses in New Mexico would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
19,447	New Mexico taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
19,927	Family-Owned Farms in New Mexico would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
