

## Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for New York Constituents

## Tax Hikes Looming for <u>New York Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- New York is home to **12,329,440** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in New York would see a 22% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$82,095, the median income in New York, would see a \$1,739 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
  - This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on New York Residents by the Numbers		
2,092,930	New York families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
90%	of New York taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
1,545,410	Small Businesses in New York would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
848,756	New York taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
29,118	Family-Owned Farms in New York would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
