

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for NJ-01 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for NJ-01 Residents on December 31, 2025:

- NJ-01 is home to **470,030** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in NJ-01 would see a
 21% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$85,653, the median income in NJ-01, would see a **\$1,846** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 9 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on NJ-01 Residents by the Numbers		
94,370	NJ-01 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
88%	of NJ-01 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
46,570	Small Businesses in NJ-01 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
20,237	NJ-01 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
329	Family-Owned Farms in NJ-01 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
