

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for NJ-10 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>NJ-10 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- NJ-10 is home to **435,400** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in NJ-10 would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$73,615, the median income in NJ-10, would see a **\$1,485** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 7 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on NJ-10 Residents by the Numbers		
95,980	NJ-10 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
88%	of NJ-10 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
39,720	Small Businesses in NJ-10 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
19,447	NJ-10 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.
