


Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for CO-07 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>CO-07 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- CO-07 is home to **567,980** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in CO-07 would see a 20% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$99,041, the median income in CO-07, would see a **\$2,248** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about **11 weeks of** groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.



Impact on CO-07 Residents by the Numbers		
105,460	CO-07 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
86%	of CO-07 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
76,080	Small Businesses in CO-07 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
12,384	CO-07 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
2,052	Family-Owned Farms in CO-07 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
