

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for ME-01 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for ME-01 Residents on December 31, 2025:

- ME-01 is home to **515,730** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in ME-01 would see a
 21% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$86,981, the median income in ME-01, would see a **\$1,886** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 9 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on ME-01 Residents by the Numbers		
72,520	ME-01 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
90%	of ME-01 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
72,770	Small Businesses in ME-01 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
18,225	ME-01 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
2,259	Family-Owned Farms in ME-01 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
