

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for AL-07 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>AL-07 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- AL-07 is home to **298,580** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in AL-07 would see a 24% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$47,972, the median income in AL-07, would see a \$1,280 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



- This is worth about 7 weeks of
 - groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on AL-07 Residents by the Numbers		
67,350	AL-07 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
93%	of AL-07 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
20,940	Small Businesses in AL-07 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
2,205	AL-07 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
3,967	Family-Owned Farms in AL-07 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
