

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Tennessee Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Tennessee Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Tennessee is home to **4,346,430** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Tennessee would see a 26% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



- A family of 4 making \$67,631, the median income in Tennessee, would see a \$1,305 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
 - This is worth about 8 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on Tennessee Residents by the Numbers		
798,270	Tennessee families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
94%	of Tennessee taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
483,900	Small Businesses in Tennessee would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
47,522	Tennessee taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
61,212	Family-Owned Farms in Tennessee would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
