

## Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for MI-12 Constituents

## Tax Hikes Looming for <u>MI-12 Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- MI-12 is home to **455,170** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in MI-12 would see a **24% tax hike** if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$55,778, the median income in MI-12, would see a **\$1,263** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 7 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on MI-12 Residents by the Numbers		
73,560	MI-12 families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
92%	of MI-12 taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
50,350	Small Businesses in MI-12 would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
29,327	MI-12 taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
34	Family-Owned Farms in MI-12 would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
