

## Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for Washington Constituents

## Tax Hikes Looming for <u>Washington Residents</u> on December 31, 2025:

- Washington is home to **5,120,410** taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in Washington would see a 20% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A family of 4 making \$94,605, the median income in Washington, would see a \$2,115 tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about **10 weeks of** groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.

Impact on Washington Residents by the Numbers		
866,630	Washington families would see their household's Child Tax Credit cut in half.	
88%	of Washington taxpayers would see their Guaranteed Deduction slashed in half.	
678,000	Small Businesses in Washington would be hit with a 43.4% tax rate if the 199A Small Business Deduction expires.	
127,307	Washington taxpayers would be impacted by the return of the Alternative Minimum Tax.	
301,151	Family-Owned Farms in Washington would have their Death Tax Exemption slashed in half next year.
