

Key Individual Tax Policies from the Trump Tax Cuts Set to Expire for NJ-12 Constituents

Tax Hikes Looming for NJ-12 Residents on December 31, 2025:

- NJ-12 is home to 507,830 taxpayers.
- The average taxpayer in NJ-12 would see a
 19% tax hike if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.
- A **family of 4** making \$106,709, the median income in NJ-12, would see a **\$2,478** tax increase if the Trump Tax Cuts expire.



 This is worth about 12 weeks of groceries to a typical family of 4 in the region.
